OUR STORY

HISTORY

The Newcastle Signal Box was constructed in 1936, and demonstrates the remarkable technical innovations introduced at the time of its construction. It is known as a 'Type O' signal box, and prior to this design, tracks were changed using large manual levers - a cumbersome and crude way to manipulate the tracks. The Newcastle Signal Box introduced electro-pneumatic miniature levers, which are much smaller and easier to use, and manipulate the switches on the tracks using compressed air. A huge compressor was located where the dining pavilion now stands, which powered the switching gear on the tracks.

Newcastle Signal Box is unique as it was the only Type O signal box provided with an electro-pneumatic miniature lever power interlocking machine, as well as at the time of de-commissioning being one of the few remaining operational signal boxes to feature its original signalling frame. When closed, it was the last remaining electro-pneumatically operating system in Australia.

The Newcastle Railway Station precinct runs from Signal Box, back to the former Newcastle Station, an area that is of state-level heritage significance. The site still showcases the layout and development of the impressive nineteenth century Victorian railway precinct, which was based on the design approach of British engineers, John Whitton and Matthew Mason.

THE NEXT CHAPTER

The Newcastle Signal Box was de-commissioned on Boxing Day 2014 and it took five years and a lot of hard work by many, for the Signal Box to start the next chapter of its life. Newcastle Signal Box reopened as a restaurant in December 2019, offering honest food in a thoughtful space built to bring people together.

As a nod to the site's industrial past, the heritage building now features a dining pavilion made nearly entirely of steel and concrete, a beautiful steel spiral stair to access the rooftop and experience a unique view of the latest version of Newcastle city, and a mezzanine area to view the historic signalling and lever gear (you are welcome to view, please see a staff member).

Partners Andrew, Dan, George and Matt saw an amazing opportunity in the Signal Box to create a unique, fun and vibrant dining experience for Newcastle. The food at Signal Box is familiar and simple, yet clever and done well. The guys take pride in doing things properly with just about everything leaving the kitchen made in-house and from scratch. From sauces, stocks and pickles through to fresh juices, chai and sodas, the team pride themselves on doing it the hard way - something they believe is well worth the effort.
